



Extension of a Joint UN Programme of Support on AIDS in Kenya

On January 2008, the Government of the United Kingdom started financing a Joint Programme on HIV/AIDS in Kenya with an end date of 31st December 2012.

Several UN Agencies (UNFPA, WHO, UNICEF, UNDP, UNODC, WFP, UNFEM, ILO, UNHCR, IOM and UNAIDS) became participating agencies for the purpose of Joint intervention to reduce the impact of HIV/AIDS. This agreement through mutual consent was further extended to March 2013. The purpose of this addendum is to seek concurrence to this amendment of dates.

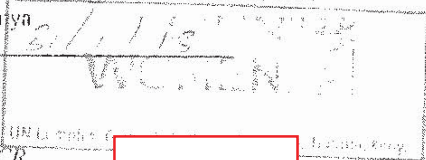
