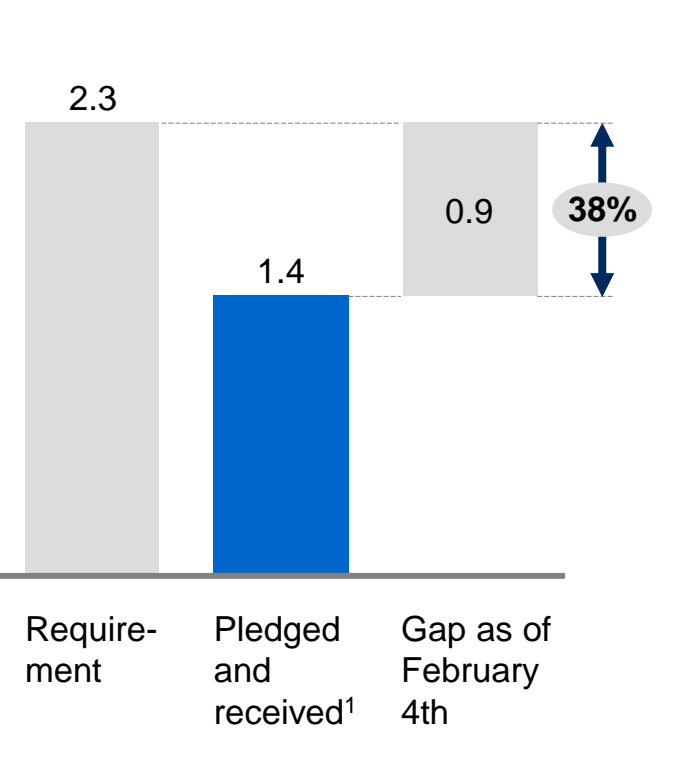

# The money you have invested has had a significant impact on the response; additional investments are required now to get to zero

USD billions

**\$1.4 billion has been pledged and received for Oct 14 – Jun 15**



## Outputs as of January 25th

- 2022 ETC beds (vs 514 in Aug 14) and 548 CCC beds (vs 0 in Aug 14)
- 26 labs (vs 8 in Aug 14)
- 5320 contract tracers (vs 3045 in Nov 14)
- 3 safe burials for every 2 reported Ebola deaths (vs 1 for 2 in Sep 14)
- 24 registered contacts per confirmed or probable case (vs 7 in Oct 14)

## Impact as of January 25th

- 80% drop in new weekly cases over 4 months (September to January)<sup>2</sup>
- 80% drop in new weekly HCWs infected over 2 months (December to January)<sup>3</sup>

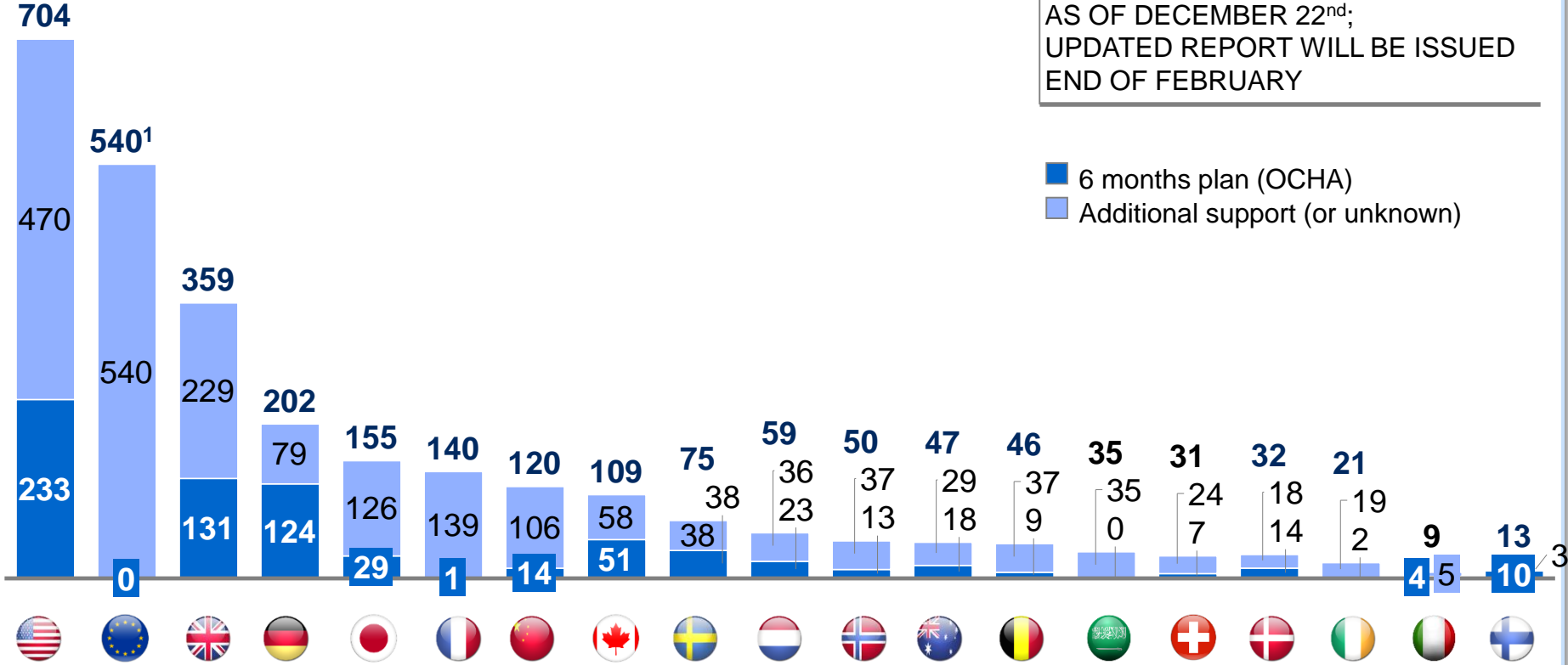


# The international community has provided strong support for response activities and budget support

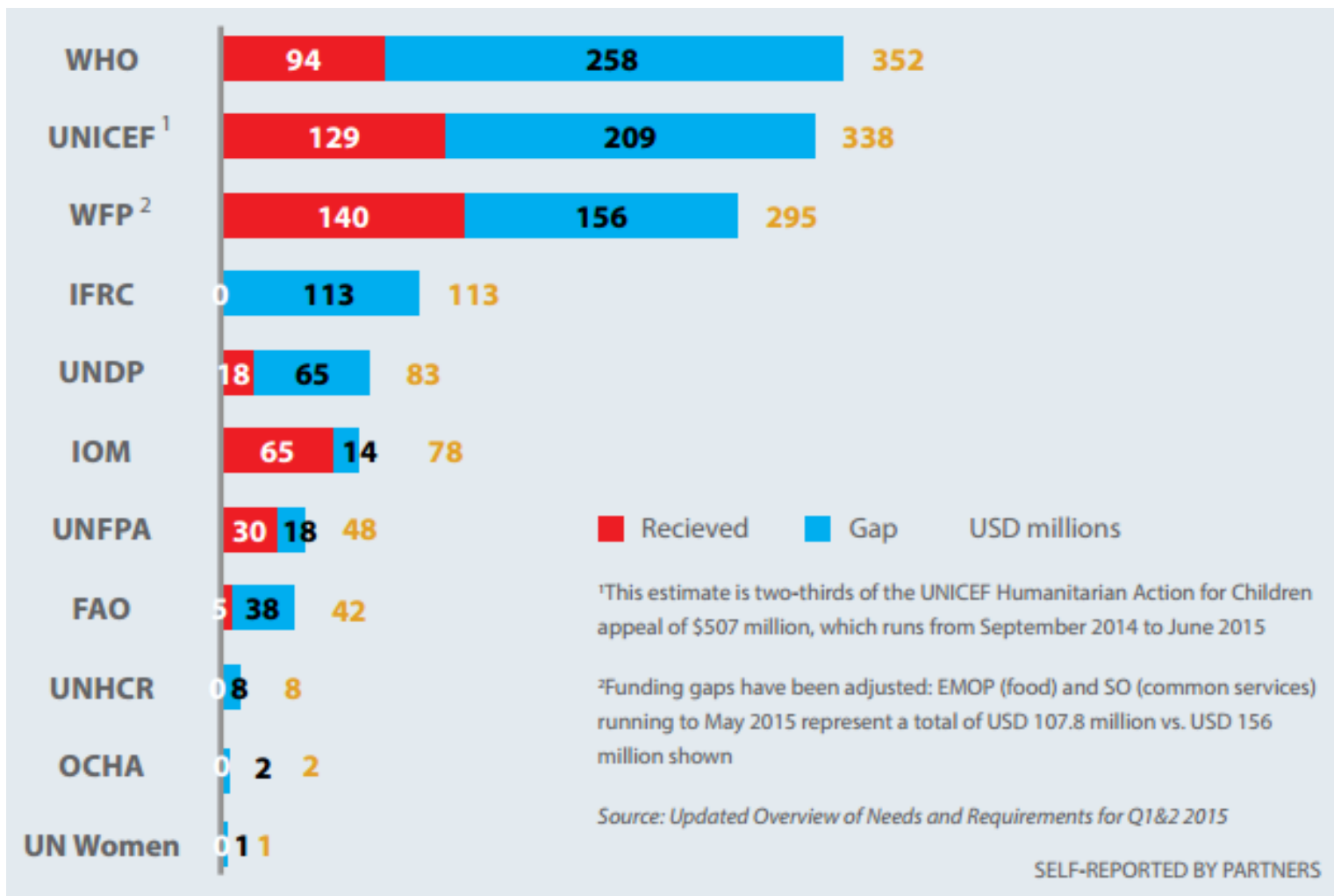
**More than 50 national governments** invested **> \$2 billion** for the response, budget support and other activities

# Secretary-General's UN Ebola Multi-Partner Trust Fund

**Trust fund is a rapid and flexible instrument to address current unfunded gap of the UN system**

Established:	20 September 2014
Duration:	2 years
Current total pledges:	\$142 mln
Current deposits:	\$132 mln (out of \$142 mln)
Current disbursements:	\$118 mln + \$ 10 mln programmed
3 Windows:	Response, Preparedness, Recovery
Governance:	Special Envoy and Advisory Committee (3 donors, 3 affected countries)
