2014 - Focus: Establishment and Expansion of SUN CSA.**2014 - First Quarter**

- SUN CSA is established with an agreed Terms of Reference and becomes functional and links up with local, regional and global SUN CSN counterparts.

2014 - Second Quarter

- Regular monthly meetings and action points is applied as a dashboard for indicating progress, challenges and bottlenecks.
- Consensus acquired on the approach and capacity assessment tool for expansion and strengthening of the SUN Civil Society Alliance.

2014 - Third Quarter

- SUN CSA organizes, supports and participates in Advocacy events for raising awareness and mobilizing the SUN approach for nutrition at the community, national, ASEAN and global levels.

2014 - Fourth Quarter

- SUN CSA selects monitoring the marketing of breast milk substitutes code as a key activity and applies the tool for pilot testing in partnership with SAVE the Children's Humanitarian section.
- SUN CSA facilitates and supports the country's representation at the SUN Global Gathering: the Civil Society Organizations' meeting for the Pre-International Conference on Nutrition (ICN2); and Civil Society participation in the International Conference on Nutrition (ICN 2) meeting.

2015 - IMPLEMENTATION AND MOVING FORWARD**Objectives:**

1. A strengthened and expanded SUN CSA contributes to the implementation of the National Programme of Action for Food and Nutrition (NPAFN 2011 -2015) through facilitating linkages between policy makers and communities.
