PLANNED RESPONSE

The project will be implemented in Saraf Omra locality, Wastani administrative unit. The project will target 10 villages namely (Um Ginifit, Sangerfoot, Jemiza feliat, Wastani, Kolonie, Bekheli, Um syiala, Debis, Alnasim, Fajra East).

This project is designed to achieve the DCPSF target by supporting stabilization of the community, with a focus on addressing the root causes of conflict in the area which is mainly a competition over natural resources, prevent conflict triggers from occurring and strengthening community based conflict prevention and resolution mechanisms at village and administrative unit level. Through, supporting effective connector initiatives such as collaborative livelihood groups (youth and women) and shared social services and promotion of a culture of peace through social exchange visit, awareness sessions on culture of peace for influential community members and tribal leaders.

Activities:

- Establish 10 peace development committees (PDCs).
- Conduct 2 capacity building trainings and workshops for training 10 Peace Development councils (PDCs).
- Two community social exchange visits targeting 5,000 people (2000 females and 3000 male)
- Two trainings on peace building culture for 20 Hakamas and 20 Ageeds for 3 days for each training.
- Establish one community vegetable farm as IGAs. Train 40 women on vegetable farming techniques
- Vocational skills training for 30 male youth on (welding). Establishment of 2 complete welding workshops for vocational training graduates
- Establish and equip one youth centre
- Establish two milling shops for the youth and women
- Organize management, savings group, and entrepreneurship skills training for livelihood committees.
- Refresher training for Migratory route committee. Demarcation of 16 kilometres of migratory routes. Logistics and communication support to Migratory route committee during the migration seasons.
- Construction of 3 classrooms and office in Um Ginifit village
- Rehabilitation of 5 hand pumps. Training of water point committees
