- Local Consultations and technical and financial analysis of selected priorities carried out in the 4 Communal Sections of Mirebalais
- Community projects selected in the 4 Communal Sections:
 - o Grand Boucan: Construction of 2 water reservoirs and community water kiosques and Water catchment, conveyance and construction of 2 reservoirs
 - o Gascogne: Local market construction and Drinkable water catchment system rehabilitation
 - o Crête Brulée: Local market construction
 - o Sarasin: Water catchment source of St-Jean, conveyance and construction of 3 reservoirs
- Tender launched for Crête Brulée, preparation of procurement files to start project implementation in Sarasin and Grand Boucan
- Meetings with local enterprises to present the tender process in Crête Brulée
- First meetings held in Centre Ville with local authorities to create the local platform
- Visit of the Special Envoy for Haiti and presentation of progress on local consultations held in Mirebalais

Risks and challenges

- Project budget revision has been submitted to respond to local priorities
- Risk of the highly-politicized environment impacting ability of project to deliver results stays high
- Communities expectations are very high. They are expected to decrease a bit as soon as implementation of community projects will start
