Key Achievements (please use this section to highlight project inputs and key achievements for the month, using bullet points or Infographics if preferred)

- As part of the implementation of projects in communities, ongoing activities are as follows:
 - > Crête Brulée: the construction of the market is over, there is a last coat of paint before the inauguration which is postponed to a later date. The construction works of the slaughterhouse have begun, up to 40% of realization. However there are some details to be settled between the firm and the procurement before the completion of the construction.
 - > Sarazin: Work is progressing up to about 80% of achievement. An amendment for additional work is signed with the firm.
 - > Gascogne: the selected firm met the different entities in Mirebalais: Community leaders, local authorities and we are waiting for an appointment with technicians from the OREPA Center. The firm begins with a topographical study to better understand the works to be done
 - > Grand Boucan: a new source has been identified. The project team visited and discussed with community members to set goals. After much discussion with the community, it has been decided to separate the project from the section in two phases: the first is to work in the Fond Cheval area because of its critical condition in water supply and the second will take into account another part of the section.
 - > Centre-ville: the management wishes to integrate the waste disposal into another waste project. The waste disposal project requires a thorough study, more time and a lot more money. The talks will continue with the authorities concerned to identify other perspectives. To this end, a meeting between the UNDP Director and community members is scheduled for early October.
- Partnership with the OREPA Center:
 - > Joint staff visit with a technician from the OREPA Center.

Difficulties

- The socio-political crisis in the country hinders activities on the ground.
- > The rainy season makes the interventions more complicated on the ground. At Sarazin the materials are transported either to men's arms or to the backs of animals.
