- The Mirebalais Community Assistance Project is a United Nations project under track 2 executed by UNDP. UNDP's interventions under this project are based on the organization's core mandate, including human and community development, and are to promote sustainable and inclusive development in support of processes to improve the living conditions of communities. The project also uses a community-based approach based on ownership of the process and the participation of all members of the community in the identification and implementation of priority projects, including the most vulnerable; the project to be created to date, five community platforms at the level of the municipality through the city center and its 4 communal sections, which are representative of all sectors and layers of the community.
- The target groups of this intervention are the communities of Mirebalais commune and especially the families most directly affected by cholera. Key stakeholders from the communal and local sections was identified and was participate in local consultations, identification, and selection of priority actions and implementation of projects. The project was ensured that women have the same access to information and the same level of participation as men in consultations and the specific needs of women are taken into account in the decision-making process on priority projects. Representatives of women's organizations was invited to join the community platform. Today, women who participate platfoms have the same right as men in the decision making.

- **Key Achievements:**
 - Two water supply projects are completed
The construction of water supply systems for the municipal sections of Gascogne and Sarasin are completed but are waiting for the OREPA-Center for the installation of hypochlorator.
 - A water supply project is running in the communal section of Grand Boucan
 - A market built in the section of Crete Brulee
 - The construction of a road in the Mirebalais downtown, the file for call for tenders available at UNDP Procurement Unit for publication
 - these built infrastructures have contributed to the improvement of the living conditions of the population of the beneficiary communities

The project has had considerable delays for the following reasons

 - Projects identified exceed the amount provided
