Improvement of cross organizational cooperation	CAPSCA-Africa participated in the Global CAPSCA Coordination Meeting of Regional Aviation Medicine Teams (RAMT) held in Singapore from 16-17 October 2010. The meeting provided a forum for networking among the various CAPSCA projects world wide as well as with other partners organizations. It was agreed that the venue for the next Global RAMT Coordination meeting would be in Africa.	50 %
2. Promotion of the Project	Information on CAPSCA-Africa was provided for posting on the newly established CAPSCA website (capsca.org)  A presentation was made on the CAPSCA-	50%

	Africa project at the meeting of Directors General of Civil Aviation in the Africa regions of WACAF (West and Central Africa) and ESAF (Eastern and Southern Africa). Six States subsequently indicated their desire to participate in the project. The Meeting agreed that airport assistance visits for aviation pandemic preparedness planning will be carried out to at least those six states before the next African DGCA meeting in November 2011.	
3. Training	Plans for a second workshop on Strengthening Pandemic Preparedness planning in Aviation to be held in Bamako, Mali from 28 February to 4 March 2011 are being finalized. The workshop will be combined with a meeting and a training session for the Regional Aviation Medicine Team–Africa as well as an airport assistance visit to Bamako Airport.	20%
3. Planning tools and Guidance material	Planning tools and guidance material available on the CAPSCA web site are being used for the preparation of workshops, training of the RAMT and for the airport visits.	50%

1. Creating awareness of the CAPSCA programme and soliciting participation :	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Forms for Notification of Participation in the CAPSCA-Africa project were again distributed at the meeting of African DGCA in November 2010, following the presentation of the Project at the meeting. Positive reactions were received from six States. More expected as awareness of the Project spreads and States recognize their responsibility under the Chicago Convention for the development of a national preparedness plan for aviation which addresses public health emergencies of international concern.</li> </ul>
