**Memorandum of Understanding
between
International Organization for Migration
and
United Nations Development Programme
regarding the Operational Aspects of the United Nations Peace Fund for Nepal**

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as “MOU”) is concluded between the International Organization for Migration, an inter-governmental organization, established by treaty and having its headquarters at 17, Route des Morillons, CH-1211 Geneva 19, Switzerland, and the United Nations Development Programme, a subsidiary organ of the United Nations, having its Headquarters at One United Nations Plaza, New York, New York 10017, USA, as Administrative Agent of the United Nations Peace Fund for Nepal, (hereinafter “UNDP”);

WHEREAS, the Participating UN Organizations to the United Nations Peace Fund for Nepal have signed a Memorandum of Understanding relating to the Operational Aspects of the United Nations Peace Fund for Nepal (attached Annex A hereto);

WHEREAS, the International Organization for Migration wishes to participate in the United Nations Peace Fund for Nepal and receive funds on the same terms as the Participating UN Organizations;

WHEREAS, the Participating UN Organizations and Donors to United Nations Peace Fund for Nepal agree to the International Organization for Migration’s participation in the United Nations Peace Fund for Nepal;

WHEREAS, the Participating UN Organizations authorize UNDP, represented by its Multi-Partner Trust Fund Office, as Administrative Agent to conclude this Memorandum with the International Organization for Migration for its participation in the Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, the International Organization for Migration and UNDP hereby agree as follows:

1. The International Organization for Migration warrants and confirms that it has entered into relevant basic agreements with the governments of the countries where it will operate in connection with the United Nations Peace Fund for Nepal, as a basis for its activities.
2. The International Organization for Migration warrants and confirms that it has privileges and immunities in respect of its personnel and assets consistent with those of the Participating UN Organizations in the countries where it is to undertake activities in connection with the United Nations Peace Fund for Nepal, including functional immunity of its personnel and assets, and immunity from legal process and from search and seizure.

3. The International Organization for Migration agrees to carry out its activities on the terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding entered into between the Participating UN Organizations and the UNDP attached hereto as Annex I, which is an integral part of this MOU.

4. For Notices under this Memorandum, the addresses of UNDP and the International Organization for Migration are as specified in the attached Annex B hereto.

5. This Memorandum shall enter into force upon signature by the authorized officials of the International Organization for Migration and UNDP and shall continue in force and effect until it expires or is terminated.
