ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

Main organizational activities:

National Severe Acute Malnutrition (SAM) guidelines have been developed. Guidelines for Community Management of Acute Malnutrition (CMAM) have been developed. Capacity building of health workers, health facilities and NGO staff is under way. Activities to improve food security at the household level have started. 3,356 homestead gardens have been established. 3,356 households provided with home gardening training material. Demonstration gardens in all the 68 participating schools have been established. School feeding has begun and children in schools are receiving High Energy biscuits during the school days. Baseline survey for the JP completed in 2011. 2,998 children under 5 and 1,135 Pregnant and lactating women are enrolled in the programme for management of acute under nutrition. 5,026 children under 2 enrolled in Micro-nutrient supplementation programme. Proportion of population with food insecurity is 13.5% as compared to the national average in 2009.

Problems and lessons learned:

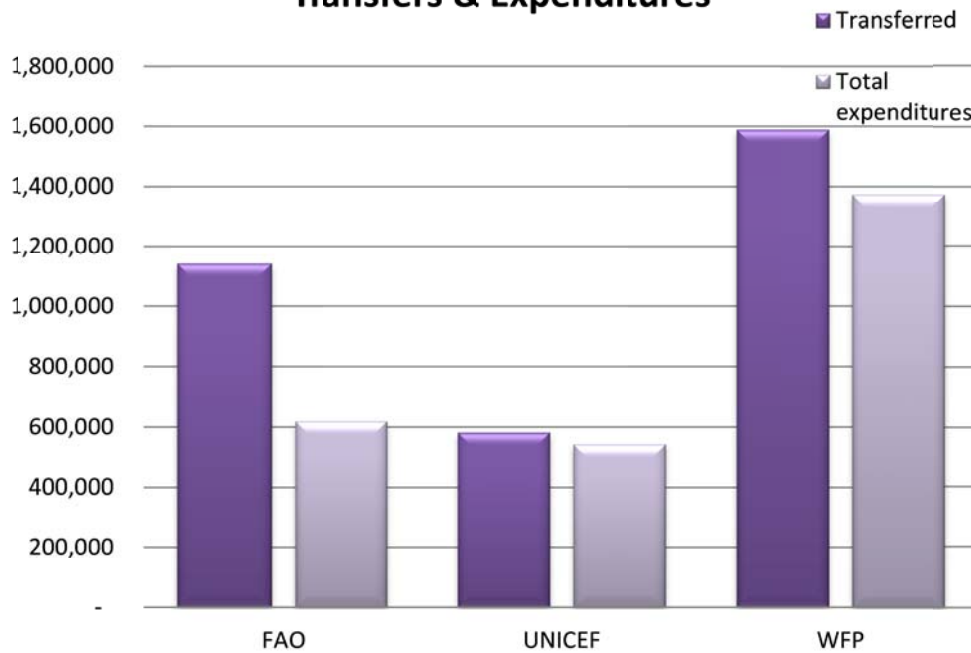
Discrepancy between expected and actual beneficiary numbers. Understaffed and poor status of health facilities in the programme areas.
