ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

Main Substantive Activities:

76% of beneficiaries surveyed were either satisfied or very satisfied with JP. The number of Government officials exposed to migrant issues exceeded the target by 133% (400 vs. 300). Information platform on migrant research established. Study on the 'new generation' of young migrants completed. Comprehensive life skills training through a participatory approach has been developed, delivered and is now being widely replicated. Social inclusion measurement indicator system and guidelines in place. Pre-employment vocational skills and business start-up training promoted employability. Target of out of school youth attending flexible courses exceeded target by 33% (752 vs. 600). Pilot community centers are providing comprehensive services and referrals. Integrated Youth development policy paper completed. Registration of migrant children incorporated into Child National Programme of Action 2011-2020. Policy on social inclusion of Young migrants in urban communities completed and forwarded to the state Council. National Conference on Youth, Employment and Migration held to disseminate the Programme results.

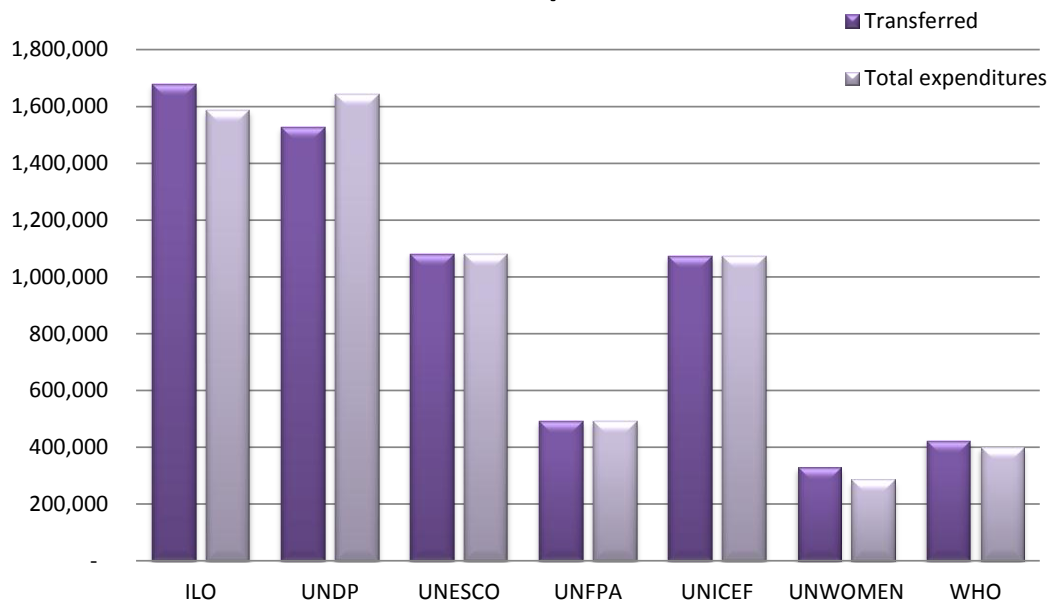
