ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

Main Substantive Activities:

A reformed version of the Penal Code was elaborated by the Ministry of Justice under the framework of the harmonization of the Moroccan legislation with international standards in regard to Gender Based Violence (GBV) prevention and the protection of children and women. There was a strong mobilization of the Women's movement in this process: an analysis of the draft of the Penal code reform according to a human rights-based approach, and submission of the proposal for amendment and a Memorandum on the gender-sensitive reform of the penal code to the Ministry of Justice. A draft law on domestic violence was submitted by the national machinery for women to the General Secretary of the Government. A draft law on domestic labour was elaborated with ongoing discussion in the Council of Ministers. Findings from a National Survey on the prevalence of GBV carried out in 2010 was published and circulated. Survey on time use by men and women covering 9,200 households in 16 regions is ongoing. Study on salary discrimination based on gender completed. The national planning, programming, budgeting system by gender is now in place. Capacity building of 18 Centers of Psychological and Legal support for GBV survivors (NGOs) in 3 regions: Marrakech, Fes, Oujda (training sessions for 80 social workers in negotiation, listening strategies, psychological support, and GBV). The regional multilateral coordination system for the treatment of GBV survivors coordinated by the Ministry of Justice is operational and has been enlarged to all the regions of Morocco. Elaboration and dissemination of the reference guide of norms and standards for the guardianship of women and children survivors of violence for the use of professionals and various stakeholders (Justice, police, gendarmerie Royale). Communal information system engendered in 6 communes to support the elaboration of communal development plans. Multi-sectoral data collection system on GBV survivors developed and set up in 5 regions. Reference guidelines, awareness programme and training tools for youth peer educators and facilitators developed. Modeling of the JP highlighting the main characteristics, good practices and lessons for national replication and/or international transfer. 259 girls under the age of 18, among which 156 girls younger than 15, have been withdrawn from domestic work and socially reintegrated--in public schools or informal education or in vocational training and learning centers. 748 girl students under the age of 15 have been preventively withdrawn from domestic work through educational support.

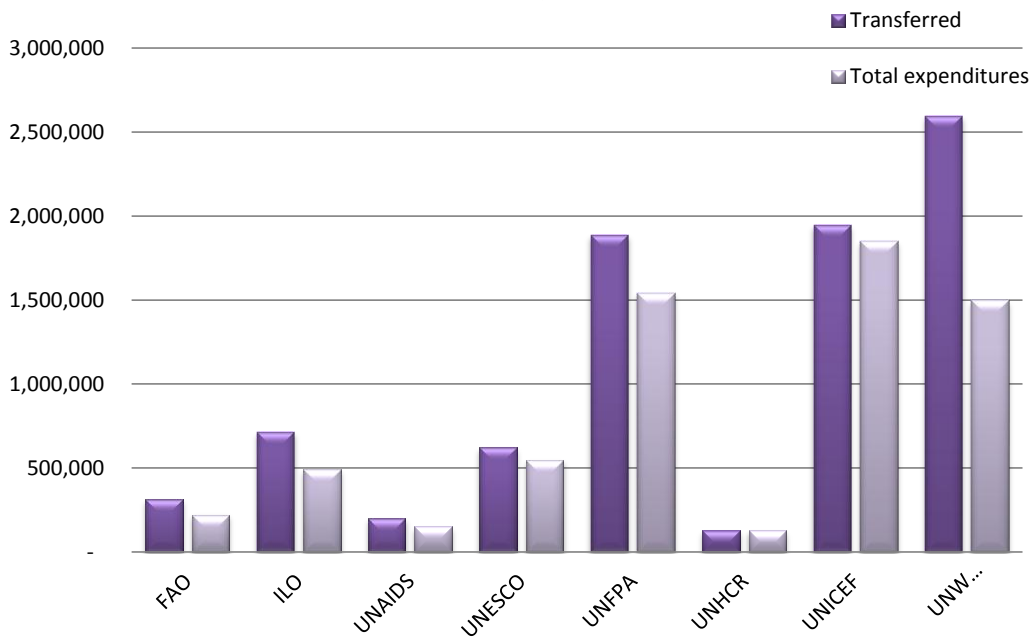
