Main Substantive Activities:

4,142 people received nutritional counseling. Overall nutrition improved due to vegetable garden programme and the improved seeds, inputs and training provided. Family planning and contraceptive training provided to community health agents. 175 people received training in family planning. 5 radio stations reaching around 235,000 people contracted to reinforce family planning awareness. 175 community agents received training in family planning. 18 health workers trained in contraceptive techniques. 412,405 people sensitized on family planning issues through various community and private sector radio stations.

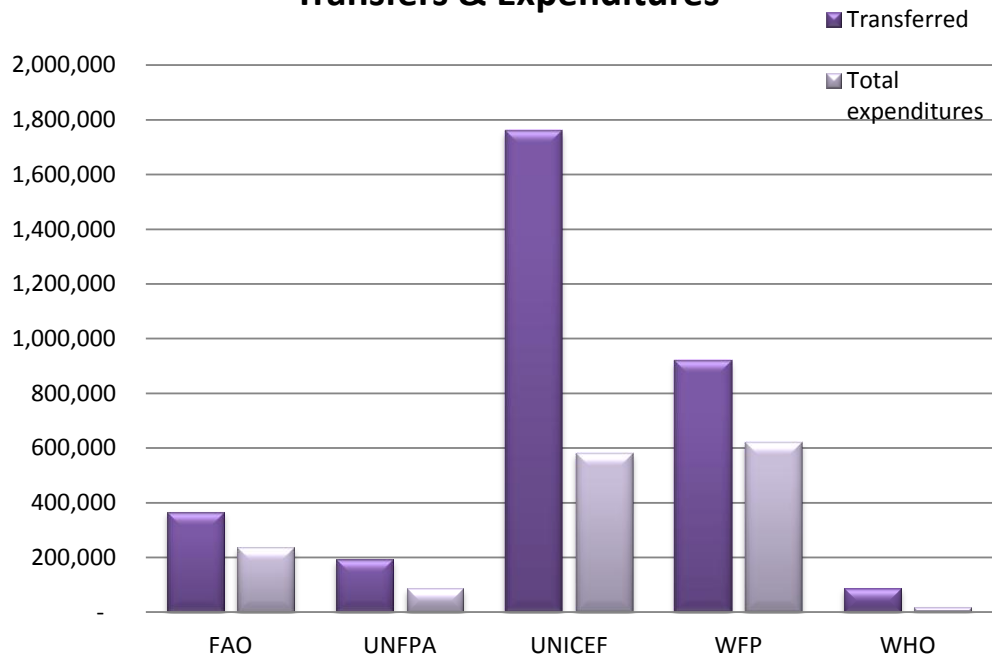
