### ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

#### Main Substantive Activities:

Milk Code monitoring trainings were completed and SMS-based monitoring hotline for Milk Code violations established. Distribution of iron-folic acid tablets to pregnant and lactating women conducted, with full coverage of the targeted 80%. Breastfeeding COMBI (communication for behavior impact) kits distributed to 32 cities; Micro-nutrient Powder distributed to all children 6-24 months in target areas in Southern Philippines (Aurora and Zamboanga City). Early Warning System for Food Security piloted in Ragay, Camarines Sur.

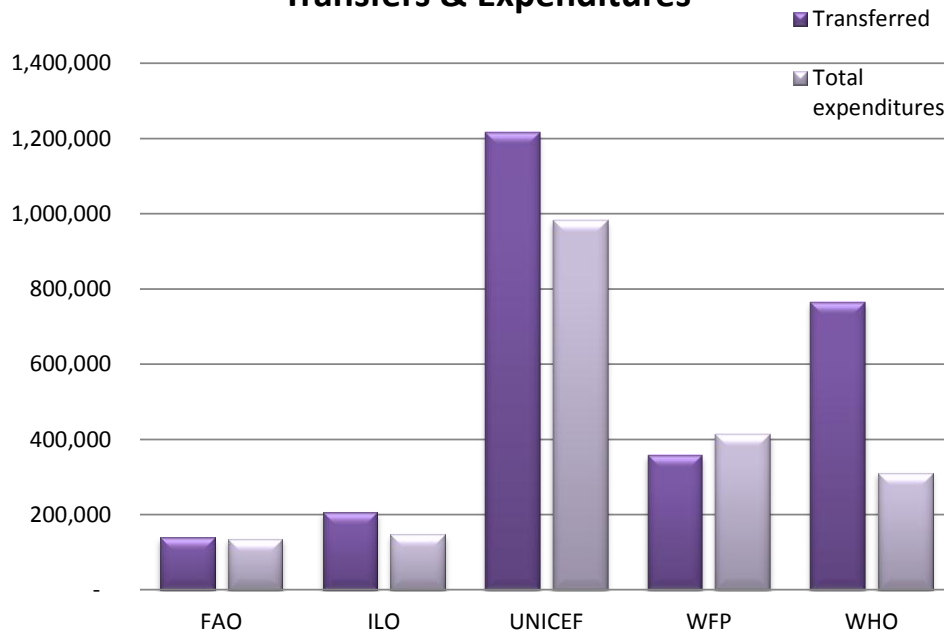
