### ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

#### Main Substantive Activities:

Framework for the National Nutrition Surveillance strengthened. New global indicators on infant and young child feeding incorporated into the surveillance system. Training sessions for 6 provinces have been conducted for both targeted technical staff and local farmers. Comprehensive training conducted for the Surveillance Dept. of the National Institute of Nutrition, General Statistics Office, Viet Nam Red Cross and others. Food Insecurity and Vulnerability Info. Mapping System has been in place for 12 communes of 6 provinces. Communication for behavioral impact training conducted. Village and community based model for promotion of breast-feeding practice were formulated. Training of Trainers conducted on Integrated Management of Acute Malnutrition. 350 farmers were provided knowledge and skills on Rice Integrated Crop Management. Report on training needs for improving small livestock production, training manual done and 160 staff from local NGOs trained.

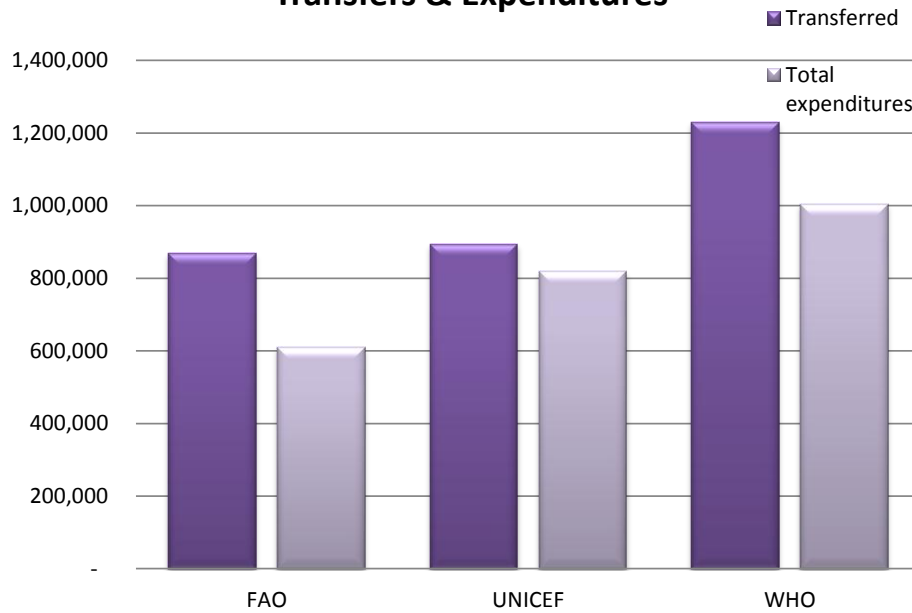
