ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

Main Substantive Activities:

Survey on Violence in the Opt and in the world of work accomplished. National Strategy to Combat Violence Against Women was endorsed by the Palestinian Council of Ministers. The inauguration of the Hayat Multipurpose Center in Gaza. 4 policy papers produced tackling vocational centers, women cooperatives, Labor law and Legislative council matters. Public servants received capacity development interventions on gender issues, advocacy, statistics analysis, psychosocial support to better serve victims of violence. Gender Knowledge sharing initiative between Opt and Morocco JP carried out about shelter management. Establishment and running of women led enterprises. Establishment of National Women's Employment Committee to advocate for increasing women participation in the labor market. The Palestinian National TV broadcasts on weekly basis episodes about Gender Equality, newsletters as supplements for local newspapers produced on monthly basis and being disseminated widely. Help line to support victims of violence upgraded. Certified trainers (Training of Trainers) delivered the gained knowledge to their colleagues. Online database exists on women in different decision-making positions. Group of professionals (social counselors, judges, lawyers, prosecutors, health providers, shelter staff, CBO social workers and family protection unit) were equipped with the needed skills on how to deal with victims of violence.

Problems and lessons learned:

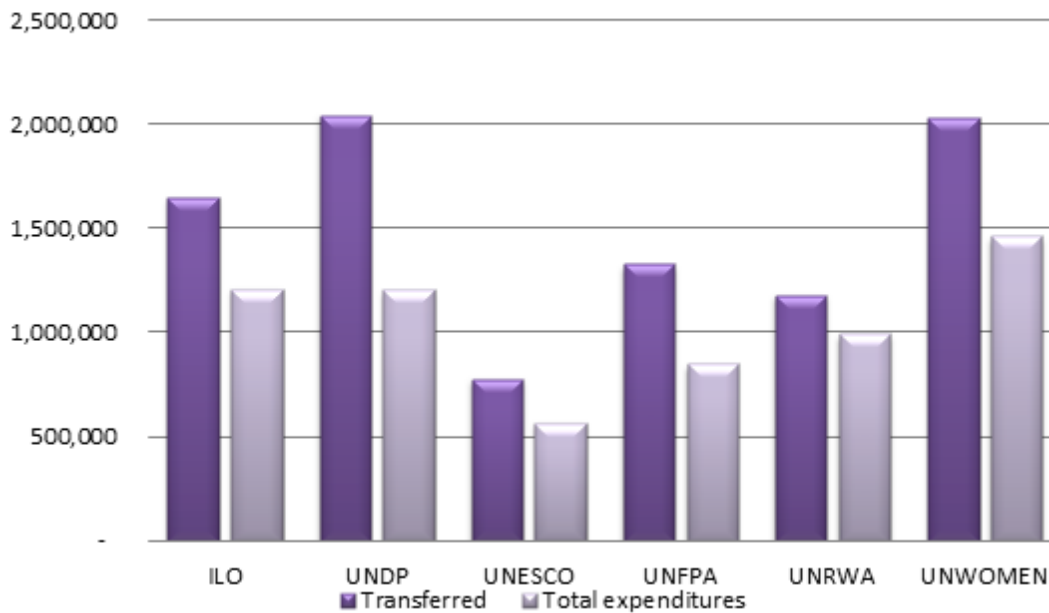
Delivering as ONE agency taking into consideration different mandates and execution modalities
