### ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

#### Main Substantive Activities:

Target of number of women trained in political, economic and social rights exceeded by 255% (3.289 vs. 1.286). Target of women who received seed capital exceeded by 214% (2560 vs. 1192). Target of women who received entrepreneurial managerial training exceeded by 228% (1483 vs. 650). Target of women trained in production techniques exceeded by 147% (1300 vs. 687). 1,010 women trained in the selection of capital goods. Target of women that have been given national ID cards exceeded by 300% (5678 vs. 1887). Local funding of USD. 227,776 secured for loan programs. in 9 municipalities. Number of women beneficiaries increased by 263% of foreseen target.

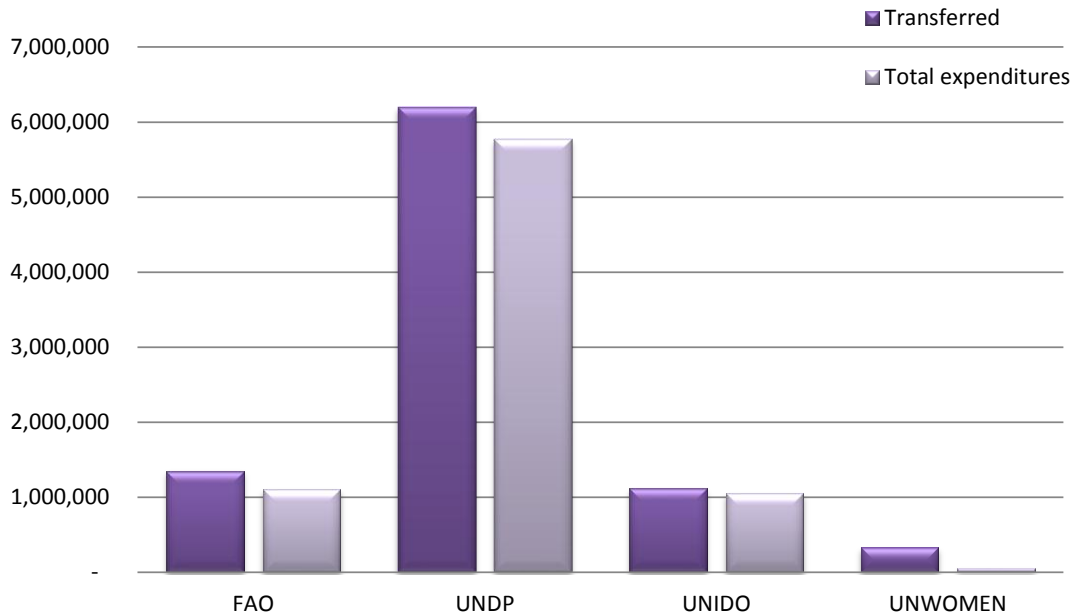
