### ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

#### Main Substantive Activities:

National micro-finance products developed and ready to be implemented through the National Program of Micro-finances. 6 local organizations trained and ready to execute micro-loans. Overall 1.618 youth involved in the programme of which 750 have received training and are being supported in job search or provided with loans through alliances with youth organizations. Within the legal framework of a law on popular economic solidarity, a policy for financing young entrepreneurs was established. 122 youth leaders trained as trainers in youth rights. The trade union agenda to promote dignified youth employment has been established and it is being implemented.

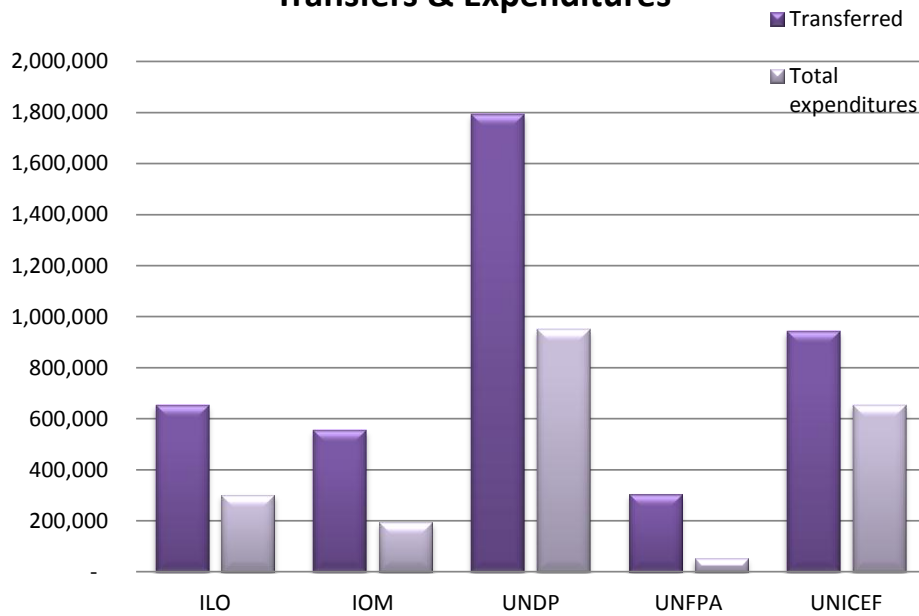
