### ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

#### Main Substantive Activities:

Commissions for Inter-Community Relations strengthened for **facilitation of dialogue between communities** in three target areas (Kumanovo, Kicevo and Struga). **Comprehensive dispute resolution system** in place. Ministry of Education and Science and other education institutions strengthened capacities for ensuring **diversity and respect for multiculturalism in curriculum and school activities**. Youth were provided extensive opportunities for inter-ethnic interaction through extracurricular activities on multiculturalism, democratic participation and the establishment of youth centres in the Municipalities. Action plans and strategies for scaling up of activities for **multicultural and democratic participation** agreed and included in the annual work plans of schools and supported by the Municipalities. . The role of tertiary education to advance peaceful inter-ethnic relations was strengthened with the establishment a UNESCO Chair, two peace study centres, and improving media courses. Capacities of media professionals were built to incorporate principles of social cohesion, cultural diversity and multi-cultural civic identity. Media response and monitoring mechanism was established and published online. Religious, social and political community leaders mobilized promoting greater cultural sensitivity and civic awareness.

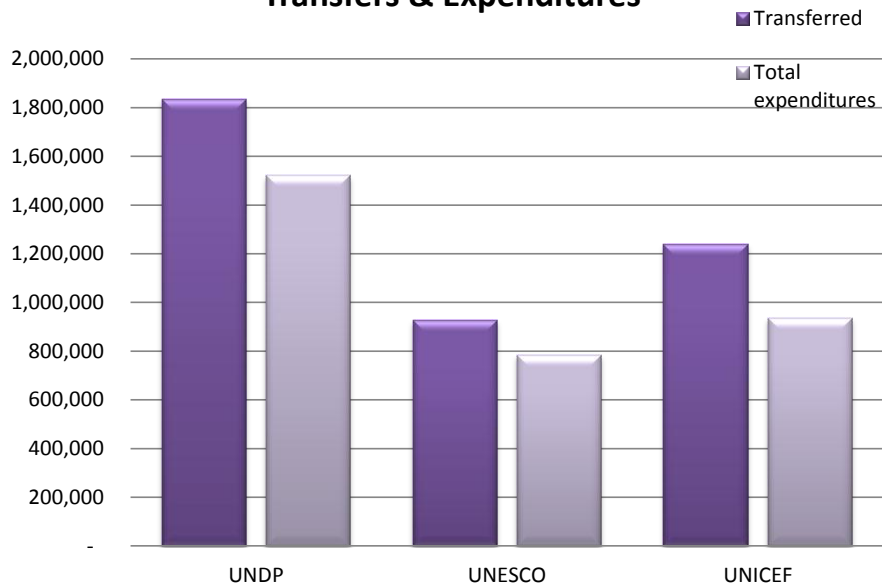
