### ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

#### Main Substantive Activities:

9,595 women in 15 municipalities have been trained in fields such as enterprise development, agricultural practices and computer skills, exceeding the target by 258% (9,595 women vs. 3712). 6,213 women received sexual and reproductive health attention, including cancer detection, exceeding the target by 345% (6,213 vs. 1800). Six infant care facilities were renovated and equipped and provided attention for 800 children of participating women. Two regional secretariats were strengthened in the Autonomous Regions of the Atlantic Coast. 9,728 women improved their livelihood through 16 projects for agricultural production and access to potable water, exceeding the target by 194% (9,728 women vs. 5,000). A manual for project management with a gender perspective was formulated. The number of health workers trained to deal with violence against women was increased by 101% over the originally targeted number. 25% more municipal workers were trained on gender related issues. 443 women community leaders were trained in the incorporation of gender practices in project design exceeding the target by 147%.

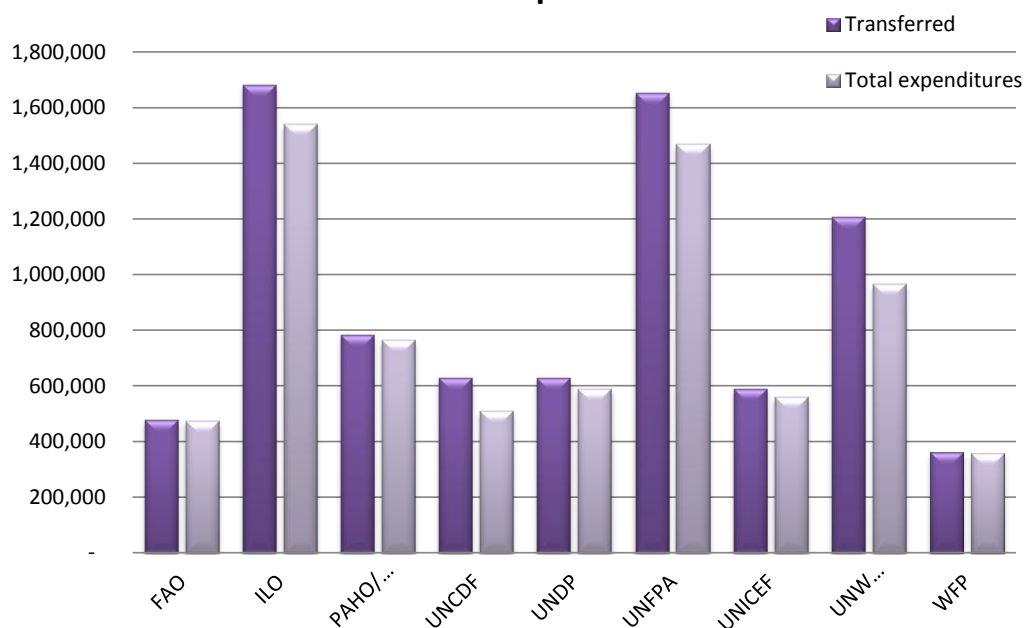
