Employment offices strengthened. Secure migration awareness increased. National Youth Employment directorate strengthened. Youth Employment policy designed and approved. Virtual one-stop youth employment window in operation. Number of home workers with health insurance and access to health centers increased. Home worker rights awareness increased. 1902 youth received training on various relevant themes. 187 youth employed in Namba APO resulting from JP support.

Lessons learned: Prioritize the strengthening of Government Institutions and generation of technical support to public policies. Support for implementation of programs for vulnerable groups under the Opportunities program.

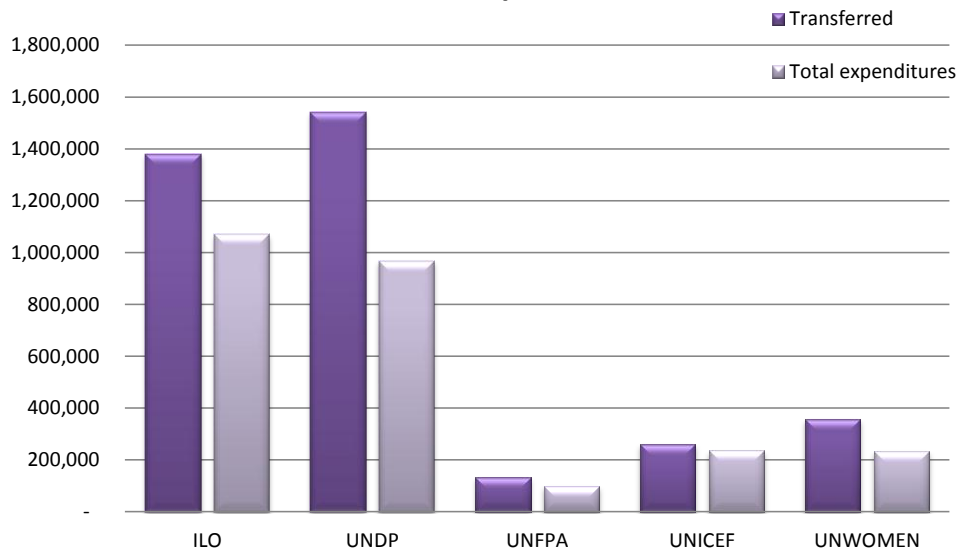
