ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

Main Substantive Activities:

The National youth employment policy's and the National and regional youth employment plans were completed. Migrant youth employment management programme completed. Young entrepreneurs development programme is 96% completed. Youth employment web based portal is operational. A migration programme for young migrants (infomigra) is available. Number of youth receiving migrant orientation/services increased by 17% over target. Several other youth employment support programmes now in place serving young entrepreneurs and other groups. 6023 youth serviced by the labour insertion programme (1000% above the JP target of 600).

Coordination with Government.

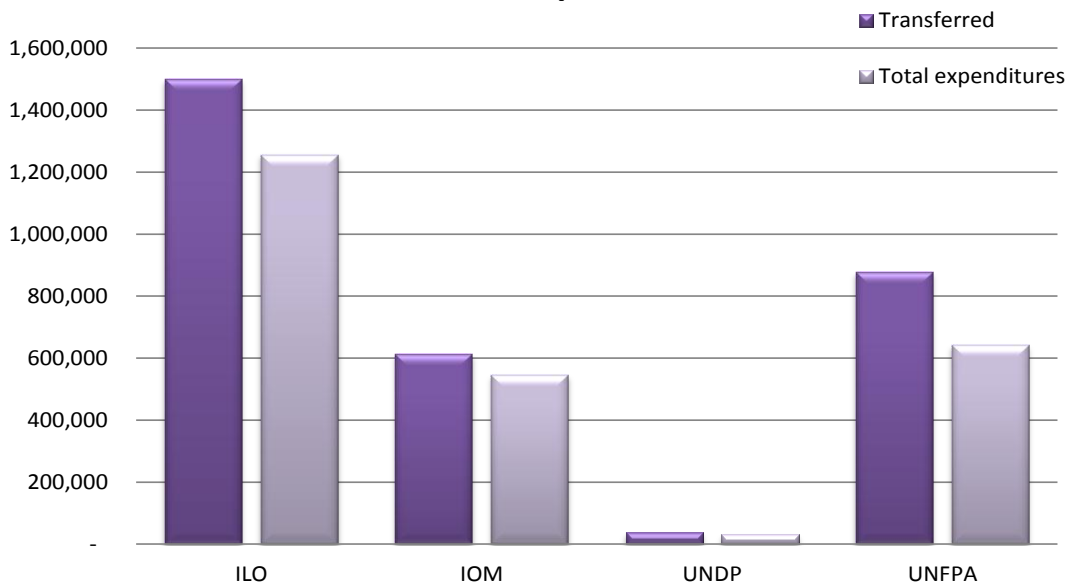
The programme has communications strategy in place:
