Main Substantive Activities:

Outline for the nutrition intervention model completed. Baseline indicators study monitored to assess impact to date. Nutritional practices and standards introduced in the communities. Knowledge exchange programmes between doctors and traditional healers organized. Indicators to follow-up on traditional health and nutrition practices established. Nutritional diagnostic for children of chosen communities done. Over 1000 mothers, babies and young children received supplements under a new nutritional complement scheme. 2102 households operating agro nutritional vegetable gardens. Several hundred hectares of rice/corn introduced in the Chocó department. A series of activities designed to ensure effective participation of indigenous and afro-Colombian population completed.


