### 2. Executive summary

This document marks the second revision and extension of the Joint Programme Document on **REDD+Partnership Secretariat Services**, the original version of which was signed on 6 December 2010. A first revision of this document was approved in October 2011. Both of these documents are available at: <a href="http://mptf.undp.org/factsheet/fund/CCJ00">http://mptf.undp.org/factsheet/fund/CCJ00</a>.

The joint programme was established to support the REDD+ Partnership through a set of secretariat services. These will be provided by the three participating UN Organizations, namely the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), as well as the UN-REDD Programme Secretariat. The Programme's objective is to contribute to the scaling up of REDD+ actions and finance<sup>1</sup>. In summary, the outcomes of the Programme – specified in section 5 – are related to: 1) Database on REDD+ financing, 2) Lessons learned on REDD+ initiatives, 3) Website to exchange views and share information, 4) Support to Partnership meetings, and 5) Co-ordination of the secretariat services all with a view to scaling up finances and actions for REDD+.

In this extension, the five above outcomes remain the same, and much of the work has been carried out (see joint programme reports - <a href="http://mptf.undp.org/factsheet/fund/CCJ00">http://mptf.undp.org/factsheet/fund/CCJ00</a>). This revision therefore focuses on one outcome; the database on REDD+ finance — (Voluntary REDD+ Database). The original Joint Programme Document is valid for all other sections, i.e. (3) Situation analysis, (4) Strategies, including lessons learned and the proposed joint programme, (6) Management and co-ordination arrangements, (7) Fund management arrangements, (8) Monitoring, evaluation and reporting, and (9) Legal context or basis of relationship.

Sections (5) Results framework and (10) Work plans and budgets are revised below in Table 2.

This Programme Document is extended to December 2014 as the overall Work Programme of the REDD+ Partnership has been extended to the end of 2014. This current revision is based on costs to enable the continuation of the Voluntary REDD+ Database (VRD) on REDD+ Financing to June 2014.

As the overall Programme of Work and Budget was only approved in June 2013, an additional amount of US \$ 162,643 was pre-approved by Partners for tasks to be carried out by the VRD team from January 2013 - June 30 2013 (of this amount, the budget approval for FAO was US \$ 112,643). This approval was to cover the following activities — maintenance of the database and website interface, data management activities, development of the 2013 questionnaire, finalisation of the analytics report, and preparation and participation of the Partnership meeting in Bonn in June 2013. When the final approval for the VRD work was provided by the Partners, an amount of US \$ 495,000 was approved to be expended for the period July 1 2013 to June 30 2014.

The overall workplan and budget for 2013 and 2014 in Annex 1, provides an integrated picture of the budget which includes funding from the European Commission to UNEP as well as components in the workplan implemented by the Facility Management Team of the World Bank.
