#### **ACTIVITIES REPORTED:**

#### **Main Substantive Activities:**

4,271 families from 44 communities strengthened in their agricultural production capacity. 44 schools have a communal vegetable garden. 274 new promoters trained in agricultural extension. 9 health centers equipped to handle women's health problems. Epidemiological surveillance system has incorporated the nutrition dimension. Technical tools developed for the use of the Ministry of Health nationwide. Over 100% of the number of families due to receive JP support on nutrition and subsistence agriculture received this support. 800 families now have metal silos. 3,542 families have established family vegetable gardens. 21 municipal councils established nutrition strategies. Literacy campaign guides and texts developed.


