Main Substantive Activities:

7 warehouses built. Agricultural, veterinary and horticultural inputs distributed. 42 project sites out of 50 planned were chosen. Direct beneficiaries of the Food for Work project were 17,320. Cereals programme direct beneficiaries were about 15,233. Campaign was done to provide vulnerable population with vitamin A, and 107,807 children were reached. 120 nutrition centers for moderate acute malnutrition operational serving 22,415 children and 5,155 women. 628 children with severe acute malnutrition were treated.


