#### **ACTIVITIES REPORTED:**

#### **Main Substantive Activities:**

Five technical municipal water/sanitation units operational (83% of target). 7.2% of population living in prioritized municipalities have seen their access to water improved (target 10%) and 5.1% have seen their access to sanitation also improved (target 6%). 293 leaders trained in community organization issues (122% of target). 91 community (30% are women) leaders trained in community water and sanitation management (300 % of target). Regional and municipal officials trained in coordination of water/sanitation activities. 24 water/sanitation projects operational in 20 communities (60% of target). Participatory approaches to water and sanitation planning have been promoted giving access to 12,928 beneficiaries. 25 communities now have water/sanitation action plans (63% of target). Over 15 water/sanitation committees are operational (38% of target). In both Atlantic Regions significant progress have been made in the elaboration of a regional water/sanitation strategy; in the southern region the strategy has been completed, while in the north it is still in process.


