Meanwhile, many NGOs are awaiting their final installment of 20%. This is a strain for both small local NGOs and large international NGOs that have multiple projects funded by the CHF. OCHA through UNDP has advertised this service and as the process of selecting an auditor is very lengthy and while waiting for this process to end a solution to the audit backlog had to be sought.
