## Sierra Leone Multi-Partner Trust Fund

## Amendment No. 2 to the Memorandum of Understanding between Participating UN Organizations, and

the United Nations Development Programme regarding the Operational Aspects of the Sierra Leone Multi-Partner Trust Fund

WHEREAS, the Participating United Nations Organizations established the Sierra Leone Multi-Donor Trust Fund starting 15<sup>th</sup> October 2009 and ending on 30 June 2013 (hereinafter referred to as the "SL-MDTF"), in support of the Joint Vision for Sierra Leone of the United Nations Family and as part of their respective development cooperation with the Government of Sierra Leone, and have agreed to build on the Government of Sierra Leone's existing aid coordination architecture and mechanisms, the "Development Partners Coordination" meeting, to facilitate the effective and efficient collaboration between the Participating UN Organizations and the Government of Sierra Leone for the implementation of the Joint Vision for Sierra Leone;

WHEREAS, the Participating UN Organizations have agreed that they should adopt a coordinated approach to collaboration with donors who wish to support the implementation of the SL-MDTF and have developed a Terms of Reference (hereinafter referred to as the "TOR") to use as the basis for mobilising resources for the SL-MDTF, and have further agreed that they should offer donors the opportunity to contribute to the SL-MDTF in support of the Joint Vision and receive reports on the SL-MDTF through a single channel;

The United Nations in Sierra Leone have now developed a "Transitional Joint Vision from 2013 to 2014", as part of their respective development cooperation with the Government of Sierra Leone.

The Memorandum of Understanding between the Participating UN Organizations, and the United Nations Development Programme (acting as Administrative Agent of the Sierra Leone Multi-Partner Trust Fund) is therefore modified as follows:

## Preamble:

WHEREAS, the Participating United Nations Organizations have developed the Sierra Leone Multi-Partner Trust Fund (hereinafter referred to as the "SL-MPTF"), which has now been amended to end on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2014, as may be amended from time to time, in support of the Transitional Joint Vision for Sierra Leone from 2013 to 2014 and as part of their respective development cooperation with the Government of Sierra Leone, as more fully described in the revised Terms of Reference of the SL-MPTF 2013-2014 dated 14 February 2013, (hereinafter referred to as the "TOR"), a copy of which is attached hereto as ANNEX A, and have agreed to establish a coordination mechanism ("Joint Steering Committee") that will facilitate the effective and efficient collaboration between the Participating UN Organizations and the host Government for the implementation of the SL-MPTF 2013-2014;

All subsequent references to the "Development Partners Coordination" meeting (DEPAC) in the Memorandum of Understanding Sections I – XI are hereby amended to "Joint Steering Committee", while Annex A is replaced by the Terms of Reference of the SL-MPTF 2013-2014.

All other terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding remain unchanged.
