Main Substantive Activities:

Report on value chain management completed. Value chain management web portal under construction. Participants of the VCMP will be identified by the end of June 2012. Needs assessment for the support of cluster, export consortia and business linkages development in the textile sector completed. Mapping of all stakeholders strengths and weaknesses done. 2 training courses for selected experts on UNIDO Cluster. Development and Export Consortia Methodology completed. Formulation of a gender sensitive participatory diagnostic study for Kahramanmaras and neighbouring provinces completed. A Sustainable Competitiveness Centre (SCC) was operationalized and the first round of advisory and training activities on implementation, mamagement and marketing related issues were carried out. Surveys conducted in 4 provinces to prepare situation analysis reports on a) sustainability, b) environmental conditions, c) working conditions and d) gender equality. A draft Assessment Report on CSR is prepared. This CSR Report will be completed in June 2012. Assessment of environmental conduct of SMEs in textile and clothing sectors elaborated. Situation Analysis for SMEs in textile and clothing sectors. As a part of CSR capacity development on environmental conduct and working conditions implemented and delivered to 100 managers, 750 workers & 10 experts of local business advisory institutions.


