## 3. Reason Revision is being requested

- 1.) Through this specific project, FAO Somalia intended to target 400 returnee households; 200 returnee households in Baidoa district respectively. However, due to the higher influx of returnee households into Baidoa district, FAO Somalia has increased the target population in Baidoa district from 200 to 400 returnee households for the following reasons;
- The actual number of returnee households who arrived in Baidoa is 2,175 (13,050 individuals).
- All the returnees in Baidoa district are considered to be more vulnerable than those in Wnala Weine, because they are agro pastorals and practice rainfed farming. In Wanla wein, most of returnee households practice irrigated agriculture.

Wanla Weine. These include provision of an agricultural package (seeds, fertilizers and training) aiming at capitalizing on the next Deyr rainy season. Upon receipt of the first contribution instalment activities were initiated in Baidoa, but not

productive goats. within the scope of this intervention. Consequently, 175 IDP households will each receive 8 redistribution activity. A total of USD 152,000 has been allocated to the livestock component female productive goats per household.
