The MOWIP methodology comprises three components: surveys, interviews, and Fact-Finding Forms (FFF). Once all information is gathered and analyzed, validation workshops take place between the implementing partners, RESDAL and UDLAP, and representatives from the institutions being assessed.

Currently, the findings of the MOWIP assessment for the Armed Forces were reviewed during the validation workshops and formal validation is in progress. At the same time, RESDAL recently finished gathering the information from the five Fact-Finding-Forms designed for the Ministry of Security and Citizen Protection (SSPC) to describe its units. The validation workshop for SSPC is slated to be held by mid-June.

The final MOWIP assessment report will be finished by July, and three weeks are needed for its translation. As such, it is necessary to request additional time to cover any unforeseen contingencies and delays in translation, and to publicize the report.
