1. Strategic Focus and relevance

The UN has been a strong, trusted partner of the Government of Papua New Guinea since 1976 and the Autonomous Bougainville Government ABG since its inception in 2001. The eight Agencies active in the Peace Priority Working Group work on good governance, peacebuilding, prevention of violence, and increasing access to justice systems. The Group will ensure that the United Nations advocates for human rights and the importance of safeguarding cultural knowledge, practices, and skills.

2. Key Focus for 2022

- Support the signing of up to two peace agreements between opposing sides of ongoing conflicts in the Highlands region
- Launch three new initiatives - small peacebuilding grants facility, youth employment hub, and conflict tracking platform for early warning/early action
- Institutional support to the Consultative Implementation & Monitoring Council - Family and Sexual Violence Action Committee (CIMC-FSVAC) and GBV Secretariats
- Provide technical assistance for the Human Rights Defenders Protection Bill and the review of the National Gender Policy
- Implement Spotlight Initiative Phase 2
- Support GoPNG and ABG, on Bougainville matters
- Support ASF awareness, surveillance programmes and biosecurity assessment programmes in the provinces
- Covid-19 response
