DCPSF AT A GLANCE: 2022 BI-ANNUAL ACHIEVEMENTS



Key results at a glance

- → <u>17 organisations</u> on boarded and implementing the <u>USD \$10m</u> DCPSF Phase II projects.
- → The projects are implemented in a total of <u>26 localities</u> and <u>159 villages</u> covering a population on <u>1,588,718 people</u> across all the five states of Darfur.

Output one

- → 162 CBRMs with 4442 members (2584 men and 1858 women).
- → 20 of the CBRMs have been revived.
- → 3877 cases have been received by CBRMs. 3218 resolved, 442 unresolved and 217 sent to court.
- \rightarrow 893 meetings have been held by the CBRMs.
- → Most cases reported are migratory season related, followed by other conflicts of land use and ownership.

Output two

- → 115 community savings groups formed with 2537 members (1940 women, 597 men), and 16,446,060sdgs (in savings.
- → 81 income generating activity groups formed with 771 members (401 men, 370 women).
- → 77 water sources rehabilitated.
- → 44 markets stalls constructed.
- → 7 schools and 14 classrooms, 2 health centres and 3 community centres rehabilitated/ constructed.
- → 319kms of migratory routes demarcated
- → 41,000 animals vaccinated, 8 community nurseries established, 335 feddan broadcast with 710kgs of seed.
- → 337 community members given vocational training
- \rightarrow 14 sports and cultural events held to promote social cohesion.

Output three

- → 25 women organisations formed.
- → 13 income generation activity groups for women established.
- → 752 women trained in peacebuilding, conflict resolution, leadership, combating bad practises such as GBV, FGM and early marriage among others

Output four

- → 8 exchange visits carried out.
- → 3 peace forums held.
- → 4 peace networks established.
