Reason revision is being requested:

The dissociation of the basic MICS from the biomarker component of the survey (HIV, Anemia, Parasitemia) resulted in an increase in the survey budget. This gap is mainly related to operational costs (deployment of teams in the field), training of specialists and enumerators for blood tests and the acquisition of reagents.

This splitting in components was the result of an in-depth analysis by the Technical Committee based on certain factors and their associated cost implications: (i) Time required for approval by the MACRO Ethics Committee; (ii) Risk out outdated mapping of Households (iii) The Risk of expiry of certain inputs such as water quality tests and iodized salt tests; (iv) Repetition of training of enumerators for necessary update in addition to the risks of abandonment etc.

In addition to this technical constraint the data collection phase has undergone some serious security issue including a robbery of the teams on the Kaga Bandoro-Ndelé axis on Saturday 25 May 2019, 12km from Kaga-Bandoro on the axis leading to Grevai. This situation has not made it possible to reach the capitals of Vakaga (Birao) and Bamingui Bamgora (Ndele) at that time. Following this incident, violence arose in Vakaga Prefecture resulting in the displacement of more than 15,000 people between July and October. This situation has resulted in additional delay in the survey implementation.





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This request is a "non-cost extension" and is intended to:

- Build on the extension obtained by principle from the Ministry of planning and the Co-chair of MPTF in June 2019 for an initial extension until December 2020
- Reflect the delay in the survey implementation due to recent security situation in the field
- Allow additional time to raise additional fund to support the implementation of the biomarker component

The budget lines as already approved remain unchanged.
