#### 2. Reason revision is being requested:

There was a significant delay in the implementation of certain activities by the Ivoirian Government, which are prerequisites for those under the responsibility of FAO:

- i) The identification process of beneficiary producers of the two sectors (Rubber and Oil Palm) has been delayed and its completion is announced by the end of March 2021; as a result, the lists of producers and regions have not yet been provided to FAO as of 16.03.2021;
- ii) The disbursement process, set up by the government for the beneficiary producers, is slow to be put in place; as a result, cash transfers to producers have not yet started, and could, according to the estimates of the leaders from the sectors, continue until the end of June 2021. By considering one (1) more month to deal with errors and unforeseen events, realistically, the completion of the transfer operations is expected by July 2021.

In view of the above, the audit of transfers cannot be done within the initial agreed and planned time schedule. In this context, FAO has only achieved what it is possible: drafting ToRs for the various studies, setting up a mechanism for collecting complaints from producers, identifying the audit firm, regular meetings with the line ministries and partners to discuss the difficulties and proposed solutions to overcome them, validation of the mechanisms proposed by the umbrella organizations for cash transfers to targeted producers, etc.

Considering that, without an extension of the project until **September 30, 2021**, it will be difficult to achieve the expected deliverables. The new, revised timetable is attached.
