2. Reason revision is being requested:

- (i) The country experienced a new violent wave of the COVID19 pandemic (Omicron) from December 2021 till present, which has led to the infection of several staff of the United Nations system including the ILO focal point which observed a 14-day work stoppage in January. This fact affected the implementation of some activities programmed for January
- (ii) Although most of planned activities have been started, they were not able to be finalized because the reasons listed above. Final payments from service providers and external collaborators, which were introduced in the last January, needs to be paid and requires a minimum 3 weeks to be made by headquarters in Geneva.
- (iii) All planned activities have been finalized or started, however, two contracts (PO) related to construction works for trade women beneficiaries have suffered delays in implementation due to remoteness and difficult access of construction sites and some legal problems with the land property of the construction sites. Some of the construction sites were also impacted negatively by the floods causing delays in the construction activity.



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(iv) Additionally and very importantly, the country was victim of heavy flooding between December and January, which affected the normal pace of work. This also caused delays in the finalization of on-going contracts.
