General Committee members of CSA for SUN conducted district level advocacy seminars as well as some community-level activities in their districts. An orientation session was given to 5 organizations in February 2014, who started their work in March 2014. The remaining organizations wrapped up their activities in April 2014.

The following activities took place across Bangladesh in April 2014: Sylhet Jubo Academy conducted a district level advocacy seminar in Sunamganj on 8 April; JASHIS organized a school yard drama in Hobiganj on 21 April; SKUS conducted a school quiz competition on 21 April and a district level advocacy seminar on 23 April, both in Chittagong; and ACLAB organized a drama for school children in Rangamati district on 30 April.

The seminars were attended by the local deputy commissioners, civil surgeons, police supers, private sector executives, tea garden managers (in Sylhet division), teachers, journalists, members of Government agencies, and other relevant stakeholders.

The dramas were attended by the general community people in the area; the purpose of holding the dramas in schoolyards was because this location is perceived as a safe space so women felt comfortable to attend the show.
