NARRATIVE

Situation Update (please describe critical changes, if any, in the situation that affect the project (1-2 paragraphs))

- ICAO has drafted a State Letter advising States to keep updated with the latest Ebola outbreak information on the WHO web site and to modify their Notices to Airmen (NOTAMs) accordingly. The State Letter is currently being translated into the six operational languages of ICAO and will then be published.
- Planning for the next CAPSCA Assistance Visit (Atlanta, 15-18 August) continued the US has significant traffic
 from Ebola affected west African States and the visit will be funded as part of the Aviation Ebola Action Plan. An
 opportunity will be taken to visit CDC headquarters in Atlanta during the same week in order to further explore
 ICAO/CDC/WHO collaboration opportunities regarding preparedness planning and response in the aviation sector.
- New Assistance Visits being planned for Africa during the remainder of the year include Angola, Rwanda and Cape Verde, with the possibility of hosting the African Regional Meeting/Conference in Cape Verde
- Further work was completed during June concerning the training of professionals involved in public health preparedness and response in the aviation sector.
- ICAO, with a number of partners including WHO, the International Air Transport Association (IATA), Airports Council International (ACI) and the International Transport Federation (ITF) has developed an ICAO-hosted website based on a questionnaire concerning vector control at airports:

The questionnaire was distributed to States and relevant International Organizations in June and ten responses have been received so far. Promotional activities are planned for July.

From the start of the project in December 2014 to the end of March 2016, a total of 17 AVs have been undertaken in Africa: to Benin, Burkina Faso, Equatorial Guinea, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Ivory Coast, Liberia, Mali, Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Togo, Gambia, Mauritania, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Cameroon and Niger.

Delays or Deviations (if any, briefly describe the delays or changes in focus, approach or targets, and provide a short justification for the change (1-2 paragraphs))

A total of 16 Assistance Visits (AVs) were planned to be completed during the second and third quarters of 2015 and by the end of September 10 had been undertaken. An additional two AVs planned for the third quarter (Cameroon and Niger) were completed in October. Planned AVs not undertaken in 2015 are being arranged for 2016.

Two training events planned for the last two quarters of 2015 were postponed to 2016. One has been held in the Middle East region during 29 February-3 March 2016 and the other, in Europe, is scheduled for October 2016.

An Assistance Visit scheduled for Senegal and Nigeria (27 June – 1 July) has been postponed to later in the year.
