Describe how you plan to implement these activities

The project will build on increasing coverage of the Core Programs of the EPHS provided by qualified personnel, the proper and efficient use of HMIS, use of the salary scale, adoption of the essential drug list and the institutionalization of manuals and protocols for the treatment of most common diseases. A medical doctor from dispora assigned as Project Manager and with availavility to travel will guarantee the access to the field. Coordination with other actors as WHO and Qatar Red Creasent Society (QRCS) will also ensure and reinforce the capacity building. WHO will contribute in-kind with the provision of some hospital consumables(list) and, if accessible, surgery training, ORCS will send a team of medical staff in order to work inside the Hospital, providing surgery and obstetrice.

At the beginning of the project, a monitoring plan will be set up based on the logical framework indicators. The main information will come from the HMIS in place; therefore, it will be reinforcement of the current data reliability. The Project Manager will work closely with the data collector and reporter, ensuring the diligent process and coherence in the reports. From the financial point of view, the project will support the Hospital Administrator duties. The Project Manager will work with the Hospital managerial staff and the Hospital Management Board on issues related to staff management (attendance lists, staff shifts, supervisions, ...), stocks and inventories (stationary, cleaning, drugs, IMAT,...), budgeting and financial allocations and monthly reporting. All those tools will help in the analysis of the health facility situation and to identify the weakness and strengths. The Project Manager, under the Regional Representative supervision, will be the final responsible for the follow up and implementation of the monitoring plan, establishing responsibilities between the staff, collecting all the information and making the analysis in order to determine the way forward. He/she will also be the contact person for coordinating with other stakeholders at the field level and to establish the links with Nairobi Office.
