NARRATIVE REPORT FORMAT

I. Purpose

- To improve the quality of education in Kiribati
- To make Kiribati education more relevant to the Pacific and Kiribati context

II. Resources

Financial Resources:

- UNESCO contributed \$2,000 to complete a preliminary report on the status of Education for Sustainable Development and related activities. This work informed the Kiribati ESD workshop and development of action plan which was funded from the Kiribati One Fund.
- UNESCO with support from Japanese-Funds-in Trust has been supporting activities to improve the quality of education in Kiribati during 2009-2011 through delivery of a series of teacher training exercises. The additional work supported by the Kiribati One Fund complemented this through a policy and planning workshop with the Ministry of Education.
- The main constraint with project delivery was fitting the workshops into the Ministry of Educations annual program.

Human Resources:

- National Staff: Admin support only
- International Staff: 2 Program Specialists (Apia and Bangkok) for project management and delivery of training. Admin support.

III.Implementation and Monitoring Arrangements

- The project was delivered through two workshops hosted by the Ministry of Education and a study on opportunities to develop ESD in the curriculum.
- Due to the specialized nature of the Kiribati tasks and need to maintain good contact with the Ministry of Education, UNESCO staff and known consultants were utilized in line with UNESCO's administration procedures.
- The project was monitored through use of agreements with the consultant and the Ministry of Education. Payments were only made on completion of all deliverables.
- Study as above.

IV. Results

- The ESD workshop was completed. A methodology for the curriculum study was agreed and a Kiribati plan for future ESD activities was agreed.
- The study was completed within the allotted timeframe.
- The second component was a training workshop.
- Delays in implementation were related to the busy schedule of the Ministry of Education and need to utilize mainly school holiday periods to engage Ministry of Education staff.
- Ministry of Education was the key partner. Their contribution was essential to achieving the results.

V. Future Work Plan (if applicable)

UNESCO is continuing to support the improved quality of education in Kiribati and ESD through a
number of initiatives including the development of a tool for assessing and monitoring teacher
performance and the development of a framework for climate change education.
