UNICEF has stated that children constitute 80% of the worst-affected population in the current crisis. The objective of the proposed action is to provide PSS to drought affected children in Banadir (Mogadishu) and Gedo regions (Bulet Xawo, Elwaq,Luuq, Doolow). This action is meant to reinforce and give continuity to an ongoing emergency intervention supported by Unicef education/CP and ending on 31/05/2012. By setting up CFSs with PSS activities, the intervention aims at: identifying UAMis/SC in Mogadishu IDPs camps and in Gedo region; supporting the resilience of the affected IDPs girls and boys; sensitizing duty-bearers on their responsibility to protect their children. Community based structures will be empowered to promote effective response/preventive systems to protect vulnerable girls and boys.
