New legal framework to deal with violence introduced. Permanent National dialogue in place. National integrated gender Policy in place. Epidemiological data discriminated by gender inequality. Training workshop on gender violence implemented. A national communication strategy to promote a culture of peace designed and under implementation. A national and three municipal violence monitoring centers established. Violence prevention programmes operational in 11 municipalities. Multi-sectorial violence early warning system in place. 3 laws against VAW promoted.


