ACTIVITIES REPORTED:

Main Substantive Activities:

Youth activities included in South Sudan UNDAF 2012-2013. Technical and vocational education and training (TVET) Curriculum and Development, Policy and Planning workshop held for senior managers and directors of vocational centers. 4-day livelihood skills and entrepreneurship training courses held for fish preservation, small restaurant, and baked foods in 3 different locations. 5 livelihood skills training packages and enterprise development training programmes prepared in line with target. Training to public and private organizations on Entrepreneurship Development, and Basic Welding Skills workshop conducted. Youth employment and livelihood baseline on skills and market opportunities assessment finalized and circulated to stakeholders. Training on Information Technology and hygiene and food production conducted. Module for HIV/AIDS for Vocational Training Centers completed. Training of Trainers on reproductive issues including HIV/AIDS&STI, Family Planning and GBV conducted. Women and youth conference identified main business and local economic recovery support requirements. Mid-term evaluation of the project conducted and stakeholder workshop on national strategy for cooperatives undertaken.

Problems and lessons learned: Discontinuance of UN and WFP flights to South Sudan posed difficulties. Low level of basic education and skills amongst the youth. Language barrier. Internal agency staffing issues.


