## Reason revision is being requested:

- In December 2013, the PBF Joint Steering Committee in Guatemala agreed to reallocate the funds of Result 6 of the Priority Plan to Result 2, in order to boost the creation of a new criminal investigation police body (Policia de Investigación Criminal –DIGICRI-), to strengthen the output related to PBF Monitoring & Evaluation and the functions of the PBF Secretariat. This reallocation has been managed through an amendment of the Project PBF-GTM-B1 Strengthening National Capacities for the Criminal Investigation/80403, which extended the project period until December 2014 and through the incorporation of the outputs before mentioned.
- Although the Project Amendment was approved in May 2014, the decision of the Ministry of Interior and the Public Prosecutor Office to implement the Chilean model of criminal investigation police wasn't taken until July 2014. Due to the specific capacities required, the identification and hiring of international consultants took place in October 2014, so there was a need to extend the project's implementation period until June 2015.
- Nevertheless the activities related to the Project Outcome 7 (Monitoring & Evaluation) such as the PBF Communication Strategy, the Priority Plan end-line survey, and the support to the Final PPP Evaluation Mission in Guatemala, scheduled for the coming months, need to be consolidated. The funds allocated to the Project related Outcome 7 show a remaining that needs to be executed through December 2015.
- This Non cost Extension is requested to extend the Project until December 2015, to execute those activities.
