### **NARRATIVE**

**Situation Update** (please describe critical changes, if any, in the situation that affect the project (1-2 paragraphs))

As of 28 October 2015, a total of 7 QIPs whose activities have begun in September 2015. Seven more QIPs have been selected and submitted to Finances for fund disbursement. They are expected to start in the first week of November 2015 and will last two months. Five more are on the way of being approved by the PRC. None of the QIPs has fully completed its activities yet. The first completion is expected in mid-November 2015. The electoral campaign in Guinea hindered the good course of QIP activities including field visits for supervision by the Program management. UNDP was able to identify flexible implementing partners fully aware of the current situation, and the hope is still alive about all QIP completing by 31st of December 2015 as initially planned.

**Key Achievements** (please use this section to highlight your key achievements for the month, using bullet points if preferred)

By end of October 2015, thanks to quick impact projects:

- An amount of \$215,017 has been paid to 7 QIP implementing partners in the four regions of Guinea, and a second payment of \$167,143 to six more partners is being processed.
- 4 EVD reintegration centers are under construction in the four main EVD hotspots of the Prefecture of Lola, Forest Region, and a total of 250 direct and indirect survivors will benefit from the income generating activities to operate in those centers.
- More than 2151 individuals sensitized on good practices of hygiene, 13 community hygiene committees put in place, and hand washing kits were distributed to 1893 households in the prefecture of Lola, Forest Region.
- 7 rice processing machines were offered to rice producers in the Region of Kankan, and a total of 12000 kg of maize were also distributed to needy families in communities affected by Ebola virus.
- 52,780 pieces of soap, and 235 protection kits were distributed in four villages of the Prefecture of Lola (Forest
