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As mentioned in the previous monthly report, funds were used in the initial phase of implementation to establish a total of 6 CTComs located in Kouremale, Friguiagbe, Kissidougou, Kouroussa, Bofossou and Koropara. In February 2015, the National Coordination Committee instructed UNICEF to stop the construction of the remaining four (4) CTComs.						
A total of 43 patients were admitted in the CTComs (Friguiabe); 06 of them were tested Ebola positive and transferred to the ETU.						
In regard to its post Ebola recovery plan, the government is currently reviewing options to transform ETUs and CTComs to health centres.						
In the context of the national health system recovery agenda, the Ebola National coordination is establishing a number of isolation units to be located within existing hospital and health centers across the country. The aim is to strengthen local capacity in preventing and controlling future epidemics, including improved infection prevention and control (IPC). As part of its contribution through this UNDP-MDTF funding, UNICEF is coordinating the construction of six (6) of these isolation centers in Yomou, Djiguiraye, Madiana, Dalaba, Tougue and Fria. Funds are being used to support activities related to the development of baseline technical documents, field assessment including feasibility analyses and actual site selection under the leadership of the Ebola National Coordination and actual construction of the six centers.						
UNICEF and the National Coordination have agreed on a timetable to complete the construction work (Please see annex : Power Point Presentation)						
Construction work will start on December 1, 2015 and be completed in 150 days; even fund can be committed before the scheduled end date of December 31, 2015, UNICEF will be requesting a NCE;						
Completion of construction design, identification of sites , and final validation by the Government on September 09 , 2015 have delayed the project execution;

Key achievements for the reporting period include:

Completion of technical missions for field assessment focusing on feasibility analyses and actual selection of construction sites in Yomou, Djiguiraye, Madiana, Dalaba, Tougue and Fria. This includes field trips and contracting
