

Healthy Nation Thematic Group Joint Work Plan 2021/22



Outcomes:

Health: Relevant MDAs and selected LGAs improve access to equitable, acceptable and affordable quality health services, especially for the poor and vulnerable

HIV/AIDS: Relevant MDAs, LGAs and communities expand delivery and promote uptake of sustained high impact, stigma-free HIV/AIDS prevention, treatment, care and support services, especially for adolescents, youth, men and key populations.

Nutrition: Women and children under five increase use of equitable, quality and effective nutrition services and adoption of optimal nutrition practices

Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH): Vulnerable groups have increased access to safe and affordable water supply sanitation and hygiene.
