Key results at a glance

- 17 organisations on boarded and implementing the USD \$10m DCPSF Phase II projects.
- The projects are implemented in a total of 26 localities and 159 villages covering a population on 1,588,718 people across all the five states of Darfur.

Output one

- 162 CBRMs with 4442 members (2584 men and 1858 women).
- 20 of the CBRMs have been revived.
- 3877 cases have been received by CBRMs. 3218 resolved, 442 unresolved and 217 sent to court.
- 893 meetings have been held by the CBRMs.
- Most cases reported are migratory season related, followed by other conflicts of land use and ownership.
