Brief Description

The project aims to bolster capacities and opportunities for the United Nations Tanzania for more joint, coherent and effective implementation of the United Nations Sustainable Development Cooperation Framework (UNSDCF) 2022-2027 in support of the SDG acceleration in Tanzania.

This **organizational support** project aims to advance the UNSDCF guiding principles, UN's normative agenda, UN's system-wide strategies and UN's efficiency agenda through joint programming facilitation, joint programme coordination, results-based management, coordination of UN's integrated policy support, common advocacy, communications, support to the UNCT Gender Equality, Women Empowerment and Human Rights Coordination Mechanisms (GEWEHRCM), joint strategic engagements with external partners and other Inter-Agency coordination mechanisms, strategies, other joint processes and common products.

To promote and support UN's initiatives that address interconnected challenges through integrated solutions and initiatives, Tanzania's new generation country-level multi-partner trust fund "Tanzania SDG Acceleration Fund" established a window on Cross-cutting issues through which joint funding will be sought (ref: Fund's TOR, para 3.5). While the SDG Acceleration Fund is expected to be the main funding source for the project, it will also provide a platform for cost-sharing from other sources.

Building on the successful experience provided to the UNCT under the 'Delivering as One' project during the UNDP II implementation, the new project will follow the same structure and support the following outputs:

Output 1: One Leader: Enhanced coherency and effectiveness of UNCT for achieving planned results

Output 2: One Plan: Increased capacity of UNCT to define, monitor and report on results for enhanced relevance, transparency and accountability

Output 3: Operating as One: Enhanced UNCT capacity to successfully pilot Common Back Office and harmonize business operations for efficiency gains, service improvement and reduced transaction costs

Output 4: Communicating as One: Enhanced UNCT Communication, Outreach, Advocacy and Partnerships for SDG acceleration

Output 5: Enhance UN Coordination: Effective support in advancing the UN coherence agenda in programming, resource mobilization, operations, communications and leadership.

In its implementation the project will apply the UNSDCF guiding principles, namely: (1) Leave no one behind, (2) Human rights, (3) Gender equality, (4) Resilience, (5) Sustainability, and (6) Accountability.


UNDP's engagement is in line with the UNDP's integrator mandate and aligns with the UNDP CPD 2022-2027, which encompasses operational and institutional support to the UN development system overall and the Resident Coordinator System.
